Useful Information for our Restart:

USA FENCING MEMBERSHIP: Renew or Purchase your annual non-competitive membership with USA

Fencing NOW for \$10. On August 1, 2022 (next Monday), the cost goes up to \$15. Your membership will be good through 7/31/23. Sign up online. To join USA Fencing or renew: Log-in or create an account at https://

member.usafencing.org/ Since Columbia Fencers' Club is a Premium (& insured) member club of USA Fencing, all

participants in CFC activities (fencing classes, lessons, open bouting, etc.) must be members of USA Fencing. "Drop-In" fencers from other clubs must also be USA Fencing members. CFC fencers: Please register your "Division" as "SC", and club as "Columbia Fencers' Club".



The USA Fencing season runs Aug 1, 2022- July 31, 2023. (New fencers joining after April 1, 2022 are credited with membership extending through July 31, 2023.) More info about types of memberships — https://www.usafencing.org/membership and https://member.usafencing.org/membership-types
The minimum individual membership level is called "Noncompetitive" (\$10 per year; after Aug 1, it goes up to \$15 per year). This is appropriate for all beginners, students in our classes, and noncompetitors. You can always upgrade your membership during the fencing season if you decide to enter competition.

There is a recent **new membership category** for individual members who compete called the "Access Membership" level (\$25 per year). Access members can compete at all sanctioned local tournaments (anything you can register for on AskFred, including Division Qualifiers).

The "Competitive" (\$90) membership level is only needed if you decide to compete at North American Cups or Regional point events, Nationals, or Junior Olympics. (See p. 2 of this newsletter for more information.)

COLUMBIA FENCERS' CLUB DUES/CLASSES: More information to be announced soon.

CFC REQUIREMENTS RE: FACIAL COVERINGS (mask under the fencing mask): This will still be required by CFC until further notice based on vulnerabilities of many in our group and their families.

CFC VACCINATION REQUIREMENT: CFC will also require proof of COVID vaccination for all participants AND spectators admitted into the fencing area.

ALL IN-PERSON MEETINGS STILL POSTPONED since March 15, 2020. This was our first and only halt in 35 years. Announcing our restart soon.

USE OF CFC FENCING EQUIPMENT: In compliance with USA Fencing's recommendations to minimize shared use of equipment, we will be assigning a set of gear to beginning fencers that you will take home and bring to class for each meeting. A deposit at the first class will be refunded when you return the equipment at the last class. Fencers will have an option to purchase or rent gear. You do not have to purchase any gear until you have had an opportunity to try this exciting sport. We can provide all our fencers with information about purchasing a new starter set from fencing companies, or discounted gear from the club or from fencers who may wish to sell gear they have outgrown or no longer use. Details about plans are forthcoming. [Sellers: Try on your gear and see what fits. I suggest you make a detailed inventory of whatever you may wish to sell, including description of item, size, RH/LH, brand, company, foil/epee, electric/nonelectric, its condition, etc.] We will announce a way to share information soon.

HOW DO I FIND OUT ABOUT TOURNAMENTS? Upcoming <u>local tournaments & clinics throughout</u> <u>the country</u> are listed on <u>https://askfred.net/</u>

(FRED is an acronym for Fencing Results and Events Database). Check "AskFRED" regularly as events are frequently added & cancelled. Questions? Ask Jane. You must have an "Access" level membership (\$25 per yr) in USA Fencing to be eligible to register for sanctioned tournaments.

National and Regional events are listed on the USA Fencing website.

You must have a "Competitive" level membership (\$90 per yr) to be eligible to register for the "National and Regional events."

CFC CLUB INFORMATION

SIGN-IN SHEET: Those who "owe" brownies— We know who you are and have not forgotten!! We will adapt the sign-in protocol to minimize contact and maintain social distancing.

CLOTHING REMINDERS: T-shirt, long pants, athletic shoes, socks. (Legs, ankles, torso must be fully covered)

(No shorts, sandals, crocs, or boots.) If you wear fencing pants ('knickers' that cover the knee), you must wear long socks that fully cover the leg. Safety comes first. The facility is heated and air conditioned.

REQUIREMENTS RE: FACIAL COVERINGS (MASKS UNDER FENCING MASKS):

CFC requires a mask under the mask until further notice.

The mask must <u>cover</u> the nose and mouth. "Face coverings must be two-layer cloth masks or surgical face coverings. Single-layer gaiters, bandannas, masks with vents and inserts that clip into the fencing mask and do not fully contact the athlete's face **are not permitted**." Spectators who are not fencing must also be vaccinated and wear masks.

CLASSES & CLUB SCHEDULE: To be announced soon. I will specify types of classes, meeting times, fees, etc. We will continue with both foil and epee.

USA FENCING MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT: Minimum level: "Noncompetitive" (\$15 per year)

NEW FENCERS? New fencers are welcome to contact me so I can put you on our general club mailing list to be ready when in-person instruction resumes. **New fencers (youth and adults) are welcome.** No experience or equipment is necessary. Only those fully vaccinated and willing to mask may enroll for now.
